Who We Are

Operation Walk Angels is a newly-established group of Los Angeles area women who are, through their philanthropy, helping to provide the gift of mobility to individuals in desperate need of life-transforming surgeries, primarily in developing countries.

Annual membership in the Angels is \$1,000. One hundred percent of Angels' tax-deductible donations are allocated to medical missions and patient care.

The Angels provide financial support of Operation Walk's semi-annual medical missions, which are staffed by volunteer doctors, nurses, and physical therapists. The Angels' contributions provide critical funding for medications, supplies (including implants and recovery equipment), cargo costs and transportation associated with each medical mission.

It costs, on average, \$3,000 per patient to get labs, x-rays, medications, provide hospital services such as food, laundry nursing and OR time to the patient, and the Angels donate to help offset these costs.

What makes this program unique is the connection it provides between donor and patient. Each Angel receives real-time information during our mission that follows our patients through their entire journey, from screening, to surgery, recovery, and rehabilitation. Not only do our Angels get exclusive photos and updates on patient status, but they have a chance



to get to know the individuals receiving this life-changing surgery. Patient stories provide a glimpse into their everyday lives, their struggles and obstacles, and their hopes and dreams for the future. When you become an Angel, you become a part of someone's road to recovery.
